SHORT COURSE

Entry fee

- Class 1** **BEGINNERS PAIRS** – fences approx. 2' 3''-2'6'' over a shortened course
Judged on a dressing fence with an optimum time **£10 per rider**
- Class 2** **BEGINNERS INDIVIDUAL** – fences approx. 2' 3''-2'6'' over a shortened course
Judged on an optimum time **£10**

NOT BEFORE 11.30 a.m.

FULL COURSE

- Class 3** **PAIRS** – fences approximately 2'6''
Judged on a dressing fence with an optimum time. **£12.50 per rider**
- Class 4** **NOVICE** – fences approximately 2'6''
Combination not to have been placed 1st, 2nd or 3rd in a hunter trial at this height or above. Judged on an optimum time **£15**
- Class 5** **SMALL OPEN**– fences approximately 2'6'' – 2'9''
Judged on an optimum time **£15**
- Class 6** **INTERMEDIATE OPEN**– fences up to 3' approx
Judged on an optimum time **£15**

MINI HUNTER TRIAL

A separate cross country course in a restricted area – Enter at the ringside
Classes 7, 10 and 11 open to horses and ponies of any height

- Class 7** **OPEN CLEAR ROUND** - fences approximately 1'6'' (entries until 12.00 p.m.)
No penalties for leading reins /assistance – rosettes for all clear rounds **£6**
- Class 8** **JUNIOR PAIRS** - fences approximately 1'6'' **£6 per rider**
Judged over an optimum time & a dressing fence Ponies 14.2h.h. and under
- Class 9** **JUNIOR CLASS** – fences approximately 1'6'' **£6**
Judged over an optimum time Ponies 14.2h.h. and under
- Class 10** **OPEN CLEAR ROUND** – fences approx. 2'0''
No penalties for leading reins /assistance– rosettes for all clear rounds **£6**
- Class 11** **OPEN CLASS** – fences approximately 2'0'' **£6**
Judged over an optimum time

**All the courses will be open for walking on Friday 28th April from 2 p.m.
Dogs must be kept on leads at all times, including when course walking.**



Brent Pelham Hunter Trial Rules

Penalties at each fence

First refusal - **20** penalties

Second refusal - **40** penalties

Third refusal – **Elimination**

Jumping an “L” fence – **15** penalties

- Stepping back in front of an obstacle will be classed as a refusal.
- A horse crossing its own tracks between parts of a combination fence, (e.g. A and B), will be scored as having refused
- A horse which knocks a flag or a post over will not be penalised if the horse’s head passes the correct side of the post.

Fall of Horse or Rider and Eliminations

- Any fall of horse on any part of the course, (or horse trapped on an obstacle), will incur elimination. **The competitor must leave the course immediately.**
- An unseated rider incurs **65** penalties. The rider may remount and continue if the Judge is satisfied that he or she is fit to do so. If the Judge believes that the rider is not sufficiently fit, **he or she will be eliminated and must leave the course immediately.**
- In the event of a fall of horse or unseated rider, the Fence Judge will complete an accident form.
- At the Judge’s discretion, competitors who are eliminated may continue around the course, providing that they give way and do not obstruct any other competitor. However the Fence Judges have the authority to request that **the competitor leaves the course at any time.**

Outside Assistance

- On the Main Course outside assistance is forbidden, except when the rider is dismounted.
- On the Mini Hunter Trial Course some outside assistance, approved by the judge, is permitted in all Clear Round Classes.
- In all other Mini Hunter Trial Classes lead rein competitors will be deducted 20 penalties. Up to 20 penalties may be deducted for any other assistance..

Pairs

- Competitors will be judged on their ability to jump side by side over fences which have been marked as “Dressing Fences” on the Course Plan. Penalties will range from zero for a perfectly synchronised jump, to 5 penalties when the two competitors are several horse lengths apart.

Optimum Time

- The course will be measured and an optimum time set according to weather and ground conditions on the day. The times taken and any penalties incurred by the first 6 competitors will be displayed after each class. Optimum times will not be published.

- **The wearing of head cameras or stop watches will NOT be permitted on the course**

Rosettes will be awarded to sixth place in each class.

A trophy will be awarded to the winner of every class.
